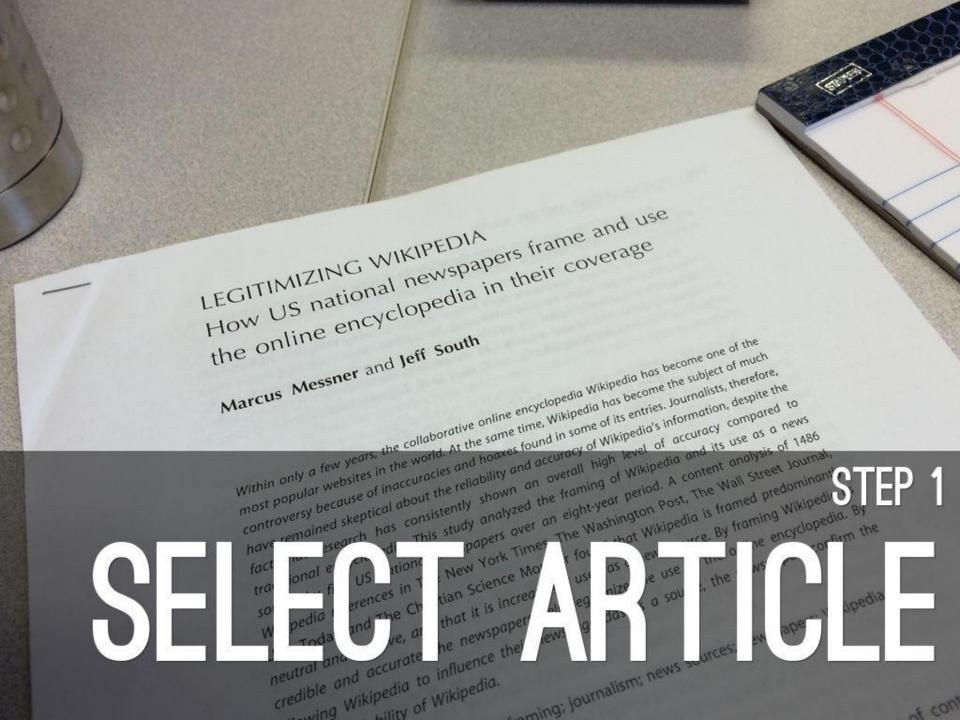

The framing and use by newspapers also has agenda-setting implications on the public's view on Wikipedia, as certain frames of media coverage and news sources have the potential to shape public opinion. Overall, this study helps to evaluate the level of legitimization for Wikipedia.

#### Framing of Wikipedia

McCombs (2005) defined five stages of agenda-setting theory: (1) issue agendasetting, (2) attribute agenda-setting, (3) psychology of agenda-setting effects, (4) sources of the media agenda, and (5) consequences of agenda-setting. This study explores two of these areas: how attributes in media coverage frame the online encyclopedia Wikipedia, and how the media use it as a source.

According to Gamson (1989), framing theory helps to analyze how certain attributes of information are emphasized over others. It is important to understand how the media frame an issue when there are a variety of options to present the information. The selection of specific facts and their interpretation have the potential to shape public opinion and influence the public's agenda (Mahon and Wartick, 2003). When journalists choose a frame for an issue, they make a consequential decision that will influence the story, but also its reader's perception of the issue (McCombs and Shaw, 1993). Wanta et al. (2004) stressed that the public learns the importance of an issue based on the
