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

Student misapplication of copyright exceptions and ignorance of copyright




Type of work determines copyright concerns

IR works are "published" works

Inability to apply most user-rights exceptions



Opportunity for copyright education



Raises student and faculty awareness

Focuses on the immediate copyright concerns

Possible approaches:

Instructor

Use standard prepared materials

Best to be aware of plans for student work **before** the works are created



Copyright in student works

Student own the copyright in their works

Institutions and faculty tend to forget about student copyright

Give consideration to possible future reuses of the student material

Non-exclusive licenses may be helpful
