SOME POINTS TO MAKE WITH ELORIAGA:

- Housing for the low-income pensioner in the No. Burnside area is a concern of the City and a goal of the Downtown Plan.
- The plan envisions this housing, as well as middle-income housing, retail and offices as good neighbors in the No. Burnside area.
- I support this goal. I encourage your efforts, along with ours and others in pursuit of ~~housing~~ this goal. (NW Nat'l. Gas)
