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## SUMMARY

This report provides population estimates for Oregon and its counties and cities for the years 1980 through 1989. As mandated by Oregon law, the Center for Population Research and Census at Portland State University, acting on behalf of the State Board of Higher Education, annually estimates the July 1 population for each incorporated city and county in Oregon. These figures must be certified to the Secretary of State by December 15. When certified the population estimates are used in the allocation of certain state tax revenues to cities and counties.

The following discussion highlights some of the changes in Oregon's population since 1980. The July 1, 1989 population estimate for Oregon is 2,791,000. This is an increase of an estimated 158,000 residents from the figure of 2,633,156 persons recorded on April 1, 1980, the date of the last U.S. Decennial Census. Oregon's population has been growing at a much slower pace during the 1980's than that of the U.S. (6.0% versus 9.6%). Additionally, Oregon's growth rate in the 1980's is less than half that of its neighboring states of California (22.8%) and Washington (15.2%).

Oregon's population is not equally distributed throughout the state. Approximately 87% of the state's population is located west of the Cascade Range. Portland is the largest city with 432,175 persons. Portland's metropolitan area, the Primary Metropolitan Statistical Area (PMSA), which consists of Multnomah, Washington, Clackamas, and Yamhill Counties has an estimated 1,202,200 residents, or 43% of the state's population as of July 1, 1989.

Virtually all of the population increase in the 1980's has occurred west of the Cascade Range. Although the total population east of the Cascade Range has changed little since 1980, Deschutes County did experience significant growth (+8500) while 13 of the other 17 counties actually lost population. However, the population reduction in these 13 counties was generally small as no county lost more than 1000 residents in the 1980's. A significant proportion of Oregon's population growth (61%) has occurred in the Portland Metropolitan Area. Washington County has recorded the largest increase (+49,000) with the other Portland area counties also experiencing significant growth: Clackamas (+23,500), Multnomah (+18,500), and Yamhill (+5,400).

The population estimates for 1989 show that Multnomah County has about twice as many residents as Washington County, the second most populous county (581,000 to 295,000). During the 1980's Washington replaced Lane as the second most populous county. As of July 1, 1989 Washington County had an estimated 15,000 more persons than Lane County (295,000 to 280,000).

The change in Oregon's population since 1980 is the result of two factors: natural increase (births minus deaths) and net migration. Natural increase has accounted for about 160,000 new Oregonians whereas there has been a net out-migration of about 2,000 persons in the 1980's. This has resulted in a net gain to Oregon of about 158,000 persons. Natural increase is relatively constant from one year to another, whereas migration can fluctuate significantly from year to year. The volatility of migration is illustrated by the inconsistent population change in Oregon from 1980 through 1986. For example, Oregon gained population in 1980, 1983, and 1984 whereas it lost population in 1981, 1982, and 1985.

Oregon has gained population in each of the last three years. In particular, Oregon's population has increased by about 101,000 persons during the past two years owing mainly to a positive net migration to Oregon of about 71,000 persons. The recent influx of migrants is reminiscent of the heavy in-migration occurring in Oregon during the 1970's.

Similar to the U.S. pattern, Oregon's population has become older during the 1980's as evidenced by the increase in the median age of the population from 30.2 to 33.8 years old. The growth of the elderly population (persons aged 65+) has been particularly dramatic and is more than triple the average population growth of the state (19.1% to 6.0%). The proportion of the population aged 65 and older reached 13.7%, up from 11.5% on April 1, 1980. This represents an increase of an estimated 79,400 elderly persons since 1980. As of July 1, 1989 Oregon has an estimated 382,700 persons aged 65 and older. Increases in the elderly population have occurred throughout the state as each of the 36 counties has a greater proportion of their population aged 65 and older in 1989 than in 1980. As in 1980, Benton County currently has the lowest proportion of elderly (9.2%). Curry County has replaced Wheeler County in having the highest proportion of elderly. In 1980, Wheeler was the only county in which the proportion of the elderly exceeded 17.0%. By 1989, eight counties exceeded this figure and in three of these counties over one-fifth of the population was aged 65 or older: Curry (23.2%), Wheeler (21.7%), and Josephine (20.2%).

Tables 1 through 8 and figures 1 and 2 provide the reader with a more detailed analysis of Oregon's current population as well as an historical look at its population during the 1980's.





## JULY 1, 1989 POPULATION ESTIMATES
