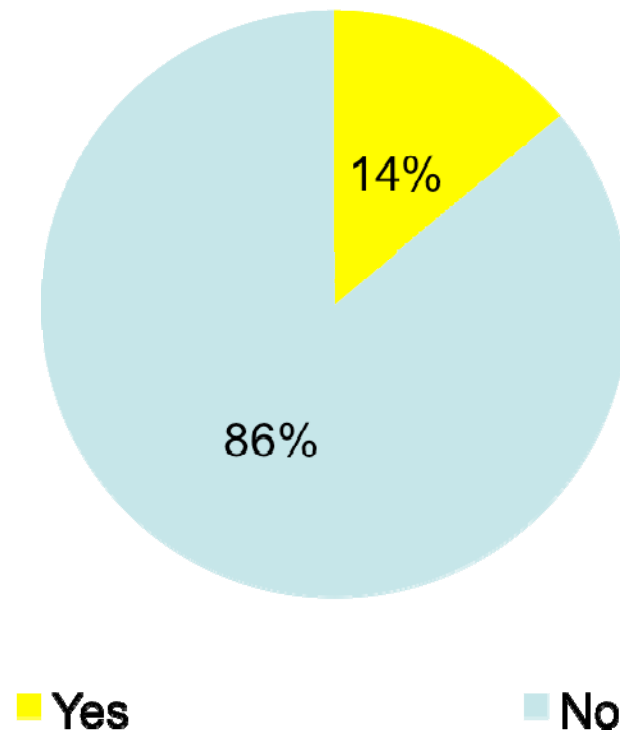

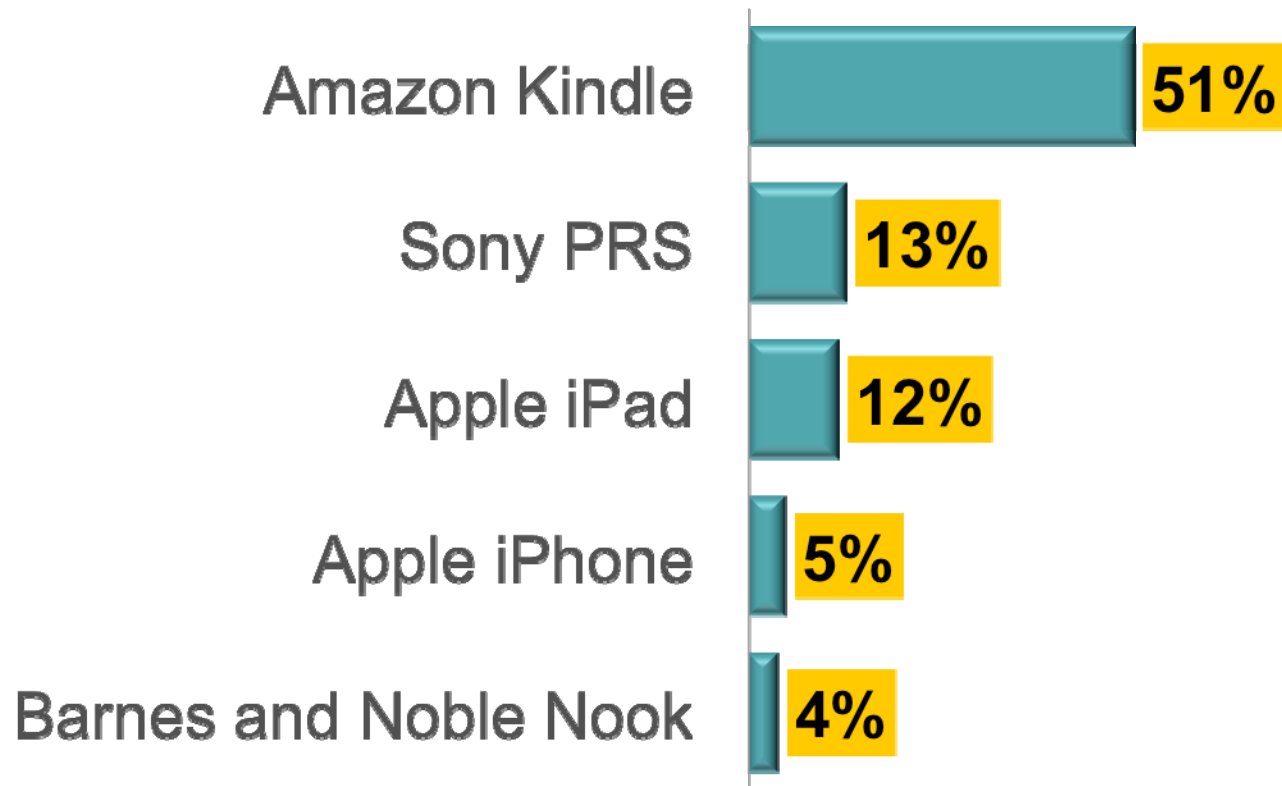
Needs Assessment Survey

What e-reader model do you use to meet business objectives?



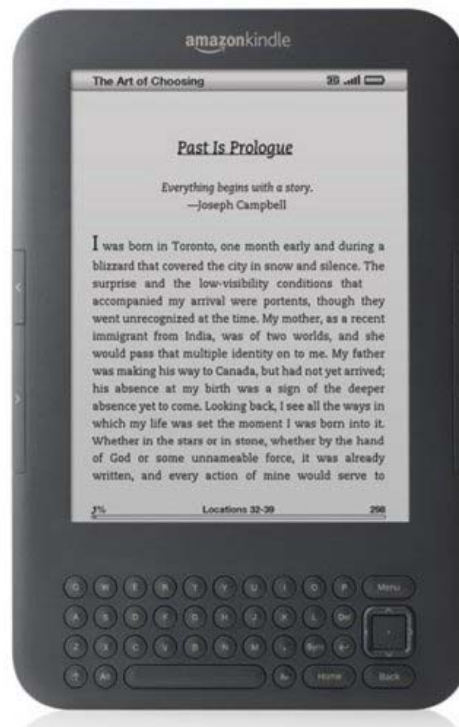

Nook

Online, SpringerLink

1. Download the files from the e-book provider.
2. Connect your Nook to your computer using a USB cable.
3. For OverDrive content, open Adobe Digital Editions, select the book you want to transfer and drag it to the Nook icon in Adobe Digital Editions.
4. For all other content, go to My Computer and move the files into the "My Documents" folder in the Nook drive.

Sony Reader

PDF or ePUB files from
getAbstract, OverDrive
Digital Books, Safari Books
Online, SpringerLink

1. Download the files from the e-book provider.
2. Connect your Sony Reader to your computer using a USB cable.
3. For OverDrive content, open Adobe Digital Editions, select the book you want to transfer and drag it to the Sony Reader icon in Adobe Digital Editions.
4. For all other content, go to the Reader Library Software, go to file, choose import files and select the title you want to import.

Additional Devices

- Any device that supports PDF, MOBI or EPUB files can be used with **getAbstract**.
- Any device that supports PDF, MOBI or EPUB files can be used with **Safari Books Online**.
- Any device that supports PDF files can be used with **SpringerLink** e-books.

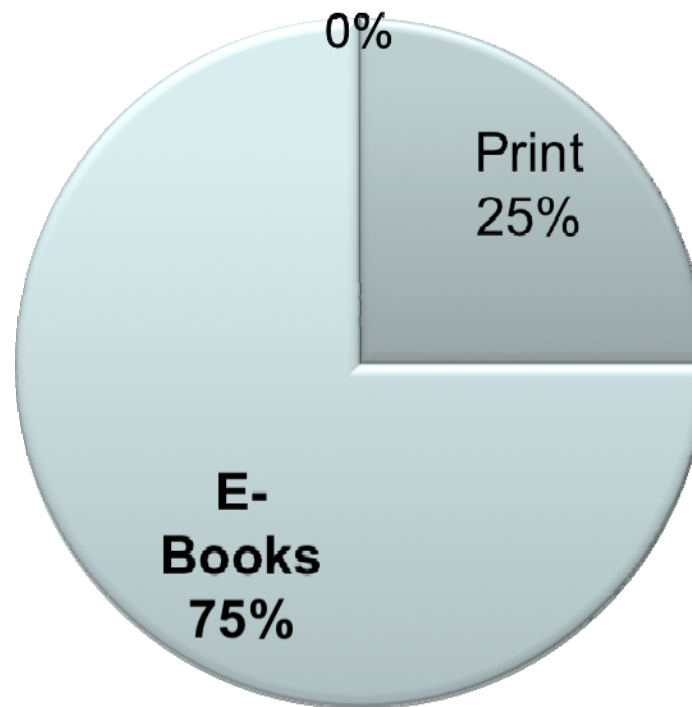
A lot has changed since January 2010, when I first blogged about compatibility between MS Library's e-book vendors and popular e-readers on the market. Since that time, new versions of the devices have made it easier to download PDFs, Apple's iPad entered the fray, and MS Library licensed new content, bringing thousands of .MOBI and .EPUB titles into the collection.

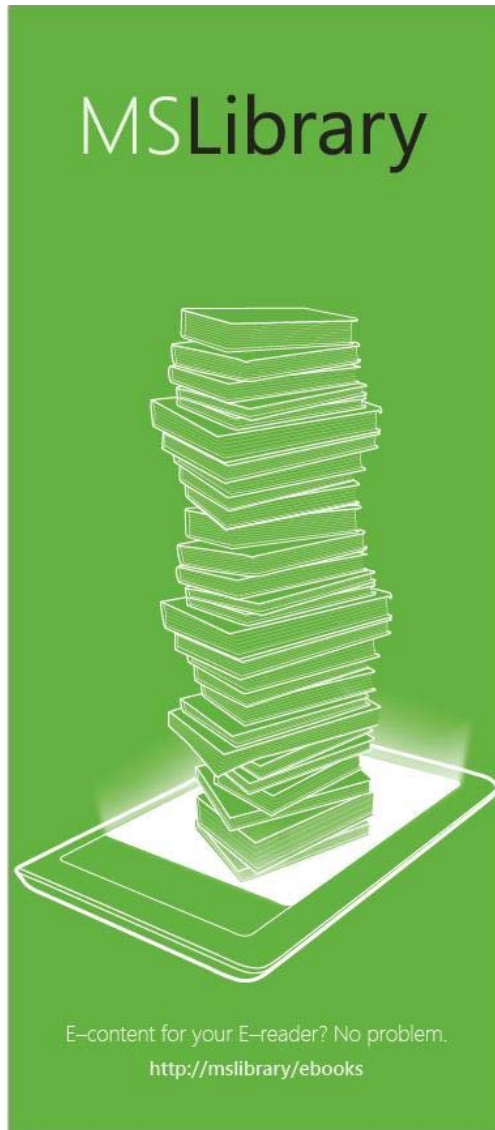
