SUMMARY

This report provides population estimates for Oregon, its counties, and cities for the years 1980 through 1994. As mandated by Oregon law (ORS 190.510 to 190.610), the Center for Population Research and Census at Portland State University, acting on behalf of the State Board of Higher Education, annually estimates the July 1 population for each county and incorporated city in Oregon. These population estimates are used in the allocation of certain state tax revenues to cities and counties.

This report has eight tables and five figures which provide detailed analyses of Oregon's current population data as well as an historical look at its population since 1980. The following three pages briefly describe these analyses.

Oregon's estimated July 1, 1994 population is 3,082,000 which represents about 1.2% of the United States population of 260,700,000. Oregon's population increased 239,679 persons (8.4%) in the 51 months since the last U.S. Decennial Census (April 1, 1990). This rate of increase is almost double that of the United States (4.8%). Oregon's growth rate in the 1990's is a continuation of the rapid growth experienced in the late 1980's when it also grew at twice the national average.

Oregon's population increase of about 239,700 persons since April 1, 1990 is the result of two factors: natural increase (births minus deaths) and net migration (persons moving to Oregon minus persons leaving Oregon). Natural increase has accounted for about 70,100 new Oregonians and there has been a net in-migration of about 169,600 persons in the 1990's.

Figure 1 shows Oregon's net migration from 1981 to 1994. It is evident from this graph that migration can vary from year to year. For example, Oregon experienced a net migration of -30,250 people from 1985 to 1986 whereas between 1986 and 1987 there was a net migration of +13,600 people. The substantial net out-migration occurring in 1982, 1983, and 1986 is reflective of the recession in Oregon in the early 1980's. Conversely, in each year from 1988 to 1994, Oregon had net in-migration of more than 29,000 people.

Figure 2 shows a map of Oregon's July 1, 1994 county population estimates. What is particularly striking about this figure is that the eight most highly populated counties are located on what may be termed the I-5 corridor. These counties (Multnomah, Washington, Clackamas, Marion, Linn, Lane, Douglas, and Jackson) contain 2,191,200 persons or 71% of the state's 1994 population. Another example of the uneven population distribution in Oregon is that although half of Oregon's 36 counties are east of the Cascade Range, these counties contain only 398,100 persons or 13% of the state's population. The percentage of Oregon's population that is east of the Cascade Range has remained constant over time; in 1980 it was 13%. Additionally, the 12 least populated counties are east of the Cascade Range.

Population estimates for 1994 show that Multnomah County (620,000) continues to have substantially more people than any other Oregon county (Table 6). Washington County is the second most populous county (359,500). Clackamas County which surpassed Lane County as the third most populous county in 1992 now has 5,500 more people than Lane County (305,500 to 300,000). At the other end of the spectrum, three counties have fewer than 2,000 people: Wheeler (1,550), Gilliam (1,750), and Sherman (1,900).

Table 6 shows that 34 of Oregon's 36 counties gained population from 1990 to 1994. The three Portland area counties of Washington (+47,946), Multnomah (+36,113), and Clackamas (+26,650) each gained more than 20,000 people during this time. These three counties have gained 110,709 people in the 1990's which represents 46% of Oregon's population increase during this time. Four other counties gained more than 10,000 people: Marion (+24,317), Lane (+17,088), Deschutes (+14,542), and Jackson (+13,611). Harney (-160) and Sherman (-18) are the only counties to lose population during the 1990's.

Approximately 13.8% of Oregon's current population (424,676) is aged 65 and older compared to the national average of 12.7%. In the 1980's, Oregon's elderly population (those aged 65 and older) grew at a substantially faster rate than the total state population (28.5% to 7.9%). This pattern has changed in the 1990's with the elderly population growing just slightly faster than the total state population (9.0% to 8.4%) since April 1, 1990. Approximately one-half of the increase in the elderly population in the 1990's is due to the aging of Oregon's population and one-half is due to net in-migration of people ages 65 and older.

Figure 4 shows a map of the percentage of elderly by county. Although the proportion of elderly in many counties is similar to the state average of 13.8%, six counties have an elderly population representing at least 20% of their total population: Curry (24.8%), Wheeler (21.3%), Tillamook (21.2%), Lincoln (20.9%), Josephine (20.7%), and Sherman (20.7%). These counties are located in different areas of the state with two in the northwest bordering the Pacific Ocean, two in the southwest on the California border, and two east of the Cascade Range. Conversely, three counties have less than 12% of their population ages 65 and older: Benton (9.9%), Washington (10.2%), and Clackamas (11.8%). Multnomah County (12.7%) also has a relatively low proportion of elderly and thus the three most populous counties (all of which are in the Portland Area) have a substantially lower proportion of elderly than the state average.

Table 4 categorizes Oregon cities by population size. Portland is Oregon's most populous city and its estimated population of 495,090 is about four times the second and third most populous cities: Eugene (120,560) and Salem (116,950). The city of Portland has more persons than any Oregon county with the exception of Multnomah. It is quite clear from Table 4 that Oregon has many small cities. Approximately one-half of Oregon's 240 incorporated cities have a population under 1,400 and only 15% of the cities have a population greater than 10,000.

As in the 1980's, many cities gained new residents because of expanding city boundaries (Table 5). Since April 1, 1990, 81 cities (one-third of Oregon's cities) annexed land containing 58,357 persons. Portland gained 46,833 residents through annexations which is about 80% of the total number of people gained through annexations. Other cities gaining more than 1,000 persons through annexations are Albany (+3,870), Bend (+3,316), and Roseburg (+1,179). The vast majority of the annexations involve few people with only 10 of the 81 cities gaining more than 100 people through annexations.

Figure 5 shows a map of the population density by county. The average number of persons per square mile for Oregon is 32; this is less than one-half the figure for the United States (74). The two most populous counties, Multnomah and Washington, have the highest population density (1,424 and 497 persons per square mile). Conversely, seven counties have fewer than three persons per square mile: Gilliam (1), Harney (1), Lake (1), Wheeler (1), Grant (2), Sherman (2), and Wallowa (2). All seven of these counties are east of the Cascade Range.
