6/9/68 City Club Committee meeting with Frank & Dorothy

1/9/69 City Club Committee meeting.

5/8/69 City Club Committee informal that the Task Force had limited its consideration to the area between the Burnside and Hawthorne Bridges.

1/7/69 Committee finds out that Task Force has completed only one study: of the costs of two alternatives — and that no planning studies had been completed.

7/3/69 Committee finds out that Frank Francis will make statement on 7/7/69 announcing adoption of a plan for development of the waterfront.

7/7/69 Newspaper reports that Frank had discussed 3 alternatives, and that decision ~~will~~^{might} be announced in a few weeks.

7/7/69 Draft statement for City Club Board of Governor's approval.

7/7/69 City Club Board of Governors meeting.
7/14/69 do " " minutes

7/28/69 City Club Board mtg.

Linkin Report approved for publication and distribution to members for presentation to club on 8/2/69.

8/2/69 City Club membership approves by ~~over~~ strong majority vote, adoption of Linkin Report of the Canal Building Site Use and Riverbank Committee.

11/70 Downtown Plan begins.

1/21/71 Hearing by State Highway Commission (last week) on closure of Harbor Drive and construction of Front-First overpass (depressed?).

7/1/68 City Club establishes Committee on Journal Building Site and Riverfront Development.

- originally established to study the disposition of the Journal Bldg; analysis of present proposals

3 Committee learns that the City had decided to raze the structure.

9/4/68 Committee meeting with Frank Wancie.

(see minutes of this meeting). [was City's "slot plan already?" decr?]

10/7/68 McCall pledges support of "...enhancement, beautification and redevelopment..." of the ~~frontland~~ west bank of the Willamette. He also established ~~the~~ Intergovernmental Task Force to "...plan and implement a massive redevelopment of the west bank of the Willamette River between the Burnside and Russ Island Bridges."

Task Force = 3 from State; 3 from City; 3 from County.

Early Nov. 1968 Task Force convenes. [no agenda; no minutes].
