Subject Pedestrian Protection on S.W. Harbor Drive

Dear Fred:

During my absence from the City, Don Bergstrom acknowledged communications from Mr. Dee Myers and Mr. Ben Medofsky relative to the protection of pedestrians on S.W. Harbor Drive. Copies of these communications along with acknowledgements to these gentlemen are enclosed.

As you will note, a copy of each acknow-ledgement was sent to the State Highway Commission. I am also enclosing the original letter from Mr. G. S. Paxson in which he states that no provision is being made for pedestrian overcrossings or undercrossings at S.W. Harbor Drive.

I thought that you would be interested in having this information. It would seem to us that should S.W. Harbor Drive become a freeway, as anticipated, provisions must be made for pedestrian crossing.
